

# MT. AIRY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The information below is provided to give you a better understanding of the Mt. Airy Road Reconstruction Project, which will begin on June 5th and is expected to be completed by August 15th.

While there will be periods of lane restrictions and (temporary) traffic pattern changes; all stores and shops at the Shrewsbury Commons and Messina Highlands shopping centers **will remain open and accessible** (via E. Forest Avenue) . There will be a two (2) week period in which Mt. Airy Road, between Walmart Entrance #3 and Madison Drive (near E. Tolna Road) will be CLOSED. During the closure, stormwater inlets will be repaired, the traffic circle will be demolished and removed, and the railroad crossing will be replaced (by the Stewartstown Railroad). At the end of reconstruction, the roadway will receive an overlay of new asphalt.

**Project Limits:** Mt. Airy Road; from E. Forest Avenue to Madison Drive

**Project Time:** June 5 - August 15, 2017

**Road Closing (Partial):** June 7 - June 20, 2017. **ONLY** from Walmart Entrance #3 to Madison Drive. The railroad crossing will be removed and replaced; there will absolutely be no access to E. Tolna Road during this time period. Buchanan Drive will also be closed to this section of Mt. Airy Road.
